Yes, it was / Were there any boots? No, there weren't. Past simple irregular verbs and regular verbs. Have to / don't have to. Comparative adjectives with more: Circus clothes are more beautiful than these. Superlative adjectives with most: This city is one of the most beautiful in the world.	Countryside: mountain, lake, forest, ground, grass, leaves, leaf, river, field, rock, tractor.  Daily routines: wake up, get up, have a shower, towel, get dressed, toothpaste, toothbrush, have breakfast.  Days of the week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.  Free time activities: listen to music, write an email, go skating, read a comic, go shopping, watch films, listen to a CD, watch a DVD.  Jobs and parties: doctor, nurse, dentist, cook, farmer, treasure, pirate, clown, film star, pop star, present.  Physical descriptions: thin, tall, straight, blonde, short, fat, beard, moustache, fair, curly.  Family: uncle, son, parents, daughter, grandparents, cousin, aunt, granddaughter, grandson.
